KB SECURITIES DECIDED TO INVEST 1.8 BILLION VND TO SUPPORT EDUCATION IN VIETNAM

As part of the plan for sustainable development activities in 2023, KB Securities has collaborated with World Vision to implement the Rainbow Classroom Project at Marie Curie High School in Hai Phong City. Nearly 1.8 billion VND of funds has been invested to support various education activities.

October 18th, 2023, KB Securities visited and worked at Marie Curie High School, Hai Phong. The school has nearly 1,000 students enrolled, with degraded facilities in classrooms and function rooms; the library has few books and needs information technology equipment. Representatives from World Vision and Hai Phong Department of Education and Training, Ngo Quyen Ward People's Committee, Vietnam - Korea Friendship Association, and other related departments also attended KB Securities' visit.

To allow children to access new sources of knowledge to develop their potential best, KB Securities decided to invest about 1.8 billion VND through World Vision Vietnam to improve and build their possible construction and installation of new facilities at the school. The project will improve facilities in classrooms, computer rooms, and foreign language rooms and expand information technology equipment to serve teaching and learning. KB Securities also started constructing an outdoor library, adding 1,500 high-quality books in many fields, helping young people have a new learning space.
