WATER SCARCITY

Barrier To Community Well-being

20% of Viet Nam's population lack access to clean water 1, exposing them, especially children, to various waterborne diseases. Every year, about 9,000 people die from poor water and sanitation, and nearly 250,000 people are hospitalized due to contaminated drinking water 2.

The situation is even more critical in rural and mountaineous regions where the lack of physical infrastructure and financial capacity significantly limit people's access to improved water sources and sanitation facilities. In Tua Chua District (Dien Bien Province), only 40.7% households had sufficient drinking water from an improved source, and only 17.3% households had improved sanitation facilities for defecations



250,000 people are hospitalized each year due to contaminated drinking water.


