ADM and World Vision launch clean water support programme to improve child health in Quang Ngai Province

Quang Ngai, April 09, 2025 — ADM and World Vision International in Viet Nam today officially launched the Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) Project to Improve Child Health in seven villages across Quang Ngai Province. Funded by ADM Cares, ADM's corporate social investment programme, this initiative marks a significant step toward improving access to clean water and sanitation for vulnerable communities in Tay Tra Bong, Tay Tra, and Thanh Bong communes.

The Clean Water Support Programme aims to deliver lasting health and livelihood benefits to children and families living in remote areas. Over the next six months, the project will construct borewells, install 2,000-liter water towers, and develop safe pipeline systems to ensure reliable access to clean water for hundreds of households. In addition to infrastructure development, the programme will engage community members in co-designing water systems, electing management boards, and participating in training on system maintenance and hygiene practices.

Speaking at the launch, Vice Chairman of Tra Bong District People's Committee – Mr. Ho Van Thinh remarked, "Access to clean water and environmental sanitation in mountainous rural areas is critically important for improving health, living conditions, and socio-economic development—especially for children and families in Tra Bong District. Your timely and effective assistance not only provides clean water but also opens the door to a healthier future for our children. The launch event brought together local leaders, community members, and representatives from ADM and World Vision to celebrate the beginning of this transformative journey. Through a holistic approach that combines infrastructure, education, and community empowerment, the project is expected to benefit more than 750 people and improve care for approximately 480 children.

The Clean Water Support Programme aligns with ADM's philosophy of promoting sustainable agricultural development and food security. By



improving access to clean water and enhancing hygiene practices, the initiative contributes to better nutrition, reduced waterborne diseases, and improved quality of life for children and farmers in Quang Ngai.

This project builds on ADM and World Vision's shared commitment to sustainable development and child well-being, following a series of impactful initiatives in Quang Nam, Quang Ngai, and Quang Tri provinces.
