Child Protection

Through integration with the livelihood component of our program, we support families in poverty to grow vegetables and raise poultry so they can provide their children with a balanced and nutritious diet.

Disaster Risk Reduction & Emergency Response

With estavvlished partnerships with local authorities and a vast network of field staff and local partners, we make sure that live-saving aid reaches the affected families and relieves their immediate needs.
